

4 Montclair Terrace Redwood Tree Hearing Summary

October 6, 2016

Hearing #1 Landmark Tree Committee Ad Hoc Meeting, quorum of 3 of 5 present, all 3 vote "yes" to proceed to support nomination of land marking the redwood tree.

October 25, 2016

Hearing #2 Full URBAN FORESTRY COUNCIL Meeting Coordinator Mei Ling Hui discussed the Landmark Tree Committee's support for the nomination of the tree. Council members decided to vote on the nomination at the next full URBAN FORESTRY COUNCIL meeting.

December 9, 2016

Hearing #3 Full URBAN FORESTRY COUNCIL Meeting URBAN FORESTRY COUNCIL members heard new information about the nomination and discussed the members' tree evaluations and consultant arborists reports. The vote was continued until the next full URBAN FORESTRY COUNCIL meeting.

January 27, 2017

Hearing #4 Full URBAN FORESTRY COUNCIL Meeting URBAN FORESTRY COUNCIL members discuss concerns raised in the January 4 letter and decide to discuss matters with the City Attorney before taking a vote on the nomination. The matter is continued.

February 28, 2017

Hearing #5 Landmark Tree Committee Meeting followed by FULL URBAN FORESTRY COUNCIL Meeting Both meetings addressed the City Attorney's recommendation to "do over" the tree evaluations "out of an abundance of caution" in response to the concerns of the January 4th letter. The results of the new evaluations will be heard and voted on at the full URBAN FORESTRY COUNCIL meeting on March 24th.

March 24, 2017

Hearing #6 All 9 members vote unanimously "yes" to support the nomination to landmark the Redwood Tree.
